History: While Brian produced his first Blend starting with the 1997 vintage of Solesce it was not until Spring of 2006 when the full line of blends was released making Brian Carter Cellars the first Washington Winery to focus exclusively on an array of blended wines. Also in 2006 Brian Carter Cellars opened its current tasting room in Woodinville. In June of 2007 the production was moved from Apex Winery in Sunnyside to Woodinville.
