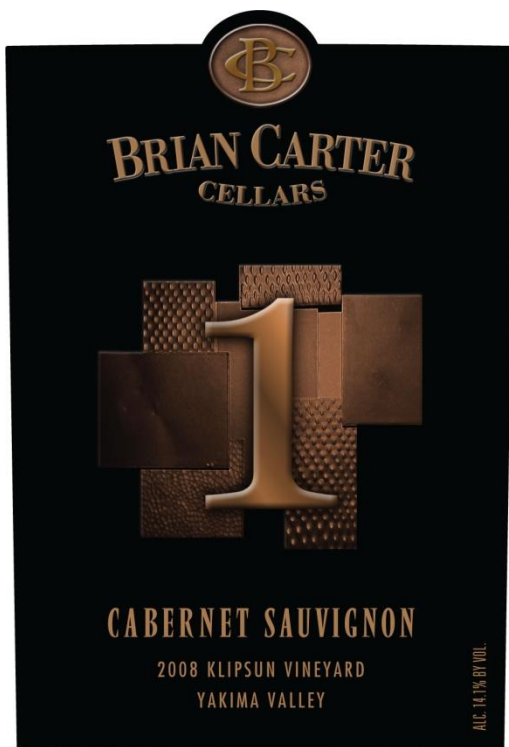




**ONE**  
**2008 CABERNET SAUVIGNON**  
**Klipsun Vineyard**  
*Red Mountain AVA*

In 2008 we set aside the second vintage of wine that seemed to embody such a gift of varietal character that they demanded to be bottled on their own. This four barrel lot of Cabernet Sauvignon from the Klipsun Vineyard was one of two 2008 Cabernet lots chosen for this honor. Klipsun Vineyards Old Block was planted in 1984 by David and Trisha Gelles on Red Mountain. Widely regarded as one of the most prestigious vineyards in the Washington, it was chosen in 2003 by Wine and Spirits Magazine as one of the top 25 vineyards in the world.



**Tasting Notes**

Dark in color, the aromas are of black currant and black cherry, with hints of charcuterie, rocky minerality and cedar. Contiguous fruit flavors along with notes of chocolate transition into firm tannins typical of the great wines of Red Mountain. This, combined with a balanced acidity and a long finish, suggests a wine that will age for a decade or more. Drink with a premium selection of beef or lamb cooked to perfection. Like most young red wines this wine can benefit from decanting up to an hour before it is consumed.
