



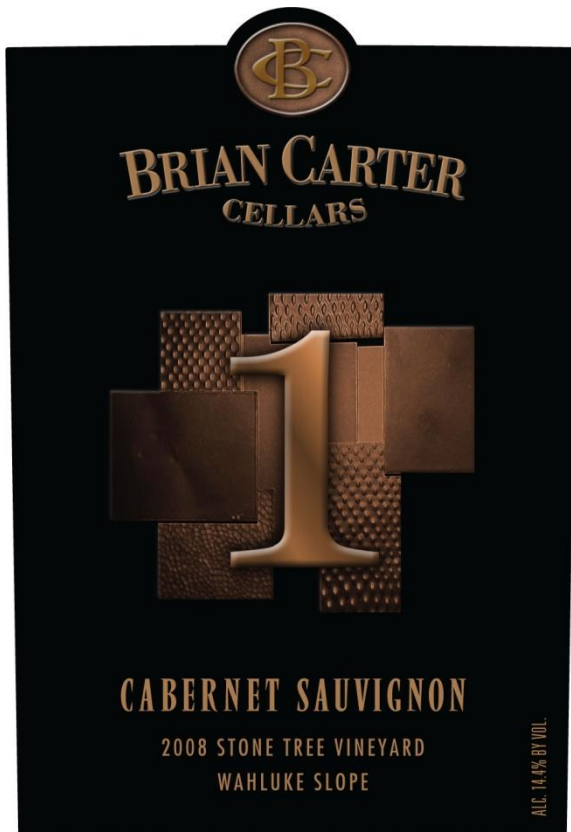
2008 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

In 2008, we set aside the second vintage of wine that seemed to embody such a gift of varietal character that it demanded to be bottled on its' own. This six barrel lot of Cabernet Sauvignon from the Stone Tree Vineyard was one of two 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon lots chosen for this honor.

This wine is dark in color with aromas of black currant, raspberry and cherry with hints of baking spices and toasted oak. Contiguous fruit flavors, supple tannins and a balanced acidity on the palate suggest a wine that will age for a decade or more. Enjoy with beef, lamb or wild game prepared with reduced red wine sauce and wild mushrooms.
