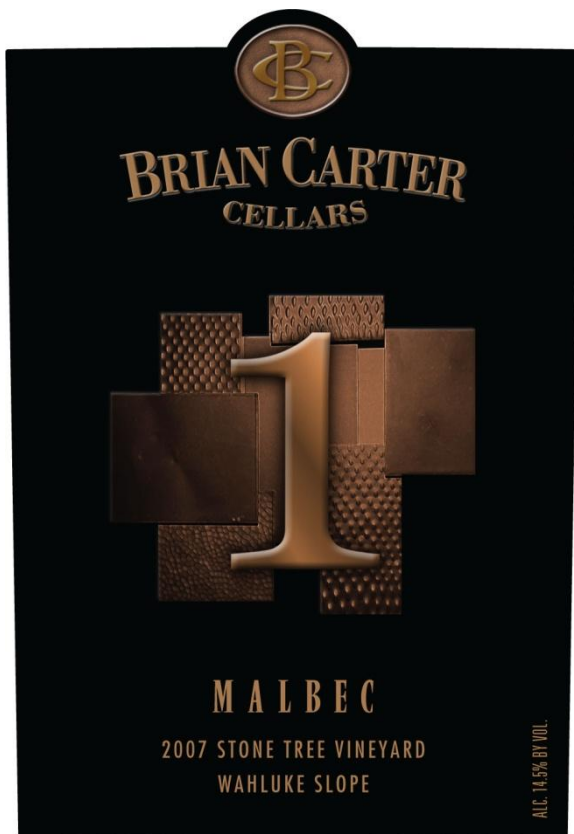




2007 MALBEC
Stone Tree Vineyards
Wahluke Slope

In 2007 we produced a few barrels of wine that seemed to embody such a gift of varietal character that they demanded to be bottled on their own. This four barrel lot of Malbec from the Stone Tree Vineyard was one of two lots chosen for this honor.

Dark almost impenetrable in color, the complex interplay of aromas includes pomegranate, blueberry, cranberry with hints of wild mushrooms and toasted oak. Contiguous fruit flavors, supple tannins and a balanced acidity on the palate suggest a wine that will improve with age. Drink with beef, lamb or wild game prepared with reduced wine sauce and a blueberry relish.
