

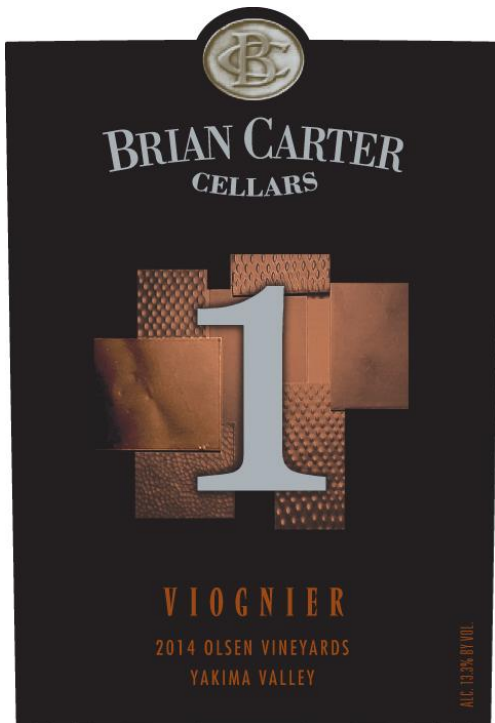


## 2014 VIOGNIER

### Olsen Vineyard Yakima Valley AVA

The wines in our Brian Carter Cellars ONE program are exceptional lots of wine that 'escape' my passionate desire to blend. While we have been making small amounts of ONE wines from half a dozen grape varieties since 2007, this wine is only the second white varietal ONE we have bottled to date. The Viognier grape was originally from the northern Rhone Valley in France where there were rumored to be only 8 acres left as recently as 1965. Today, with more than 700 acres planted in the region, the 100% varietal wines of Condrieu express a classic version of this grape.

In Washington State, the wine is widely used both as a varietal and in blends such as our delicious Oriana, which is rapidly becoming a Northwest classic. Viognier displays a light golden color in the glass and on the nose has classic ripe apricot and peach aromas with hints of pear and rhubarb. A refreshing crispness greets the palate and the wine finishes with a nice richness.
