History: Brian Carter produced his first blend with the 1997 vintage of Solesce, it was not until Spring of 2006 when the full line of blends was released making Brian Carter Cellars the first Washington Winery to focus entirely blended wines. In 2006, Brian Carter Cellars opened its current tasting room in Woodinville. In June of 2007, production was moved from the Apex Winery in Sunnyside to Woodinville.
