



## 2004 L'Étalon Bordeaux-Style Blend

This Bordeaux-style blend was crafted using carefully selected lots of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec made from select Washington vineyards. Each of these grapes possesses a unique character. Yet, when blended in the right proportions, they harmonize into one essential composition as each makes its distinctive contribution to the whole.

Richly dark in color the aroma brings forth raspberries, cassis, roasted meats, licorice, chocolate and cedar. Mouth-filling flavors show soft well integrated tannins and a food friendly balance.

Each vintage of this Bordeaux-Style Blend will be slightly different, depending on the characteristics of the harvest. In 2003 I used the following sources and varieties:
