

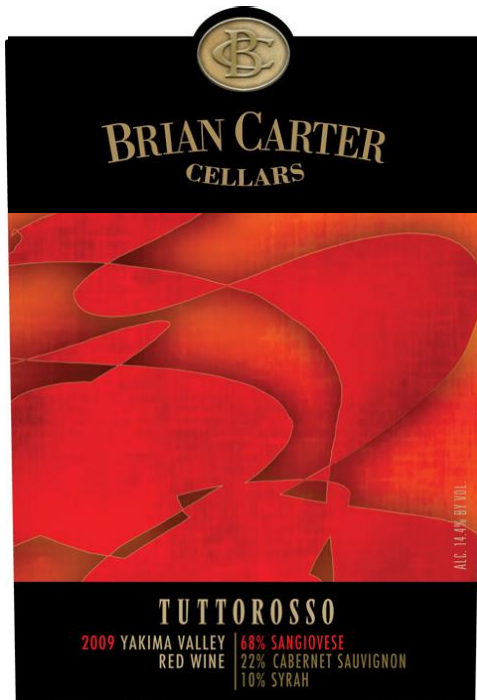

The 2009 Tutorosso Super Tuscan-Style blend salutes the maverick winemakers who broke with tradition to create a new category of wines from Tuscany.
