



Tasting Room Vaccination Verification Procedure October 25, 2021

In accordance with King County, Brian Carter Cellars is initiating the following policy to protect our staff and customers against Covid 19:

- To gain access to all Brian Carter Cellars retail or event facilities prior to entry, every time they visit Brian Carter Cellars, all individuals 12-years of age and older must provide either proof of being fully vaccinated or a negative PCR test.
- Customers *will be turned away* if they refuse or are unable to provide required documentation.
- We will also check ID of every guest to confirm identity and drinking age.
- Guests will not be allowed to be seated until their verification is complete, and a staff member is available to take them directly to their table. This will apply whether seated inside or outside.
- Guests will be asked to always wear a mask when they are not seated (i.e., when entering/exiting, using the restrooms, etc.).

Definition of “Fully Vaccinated”:

People are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving:

- Two doses of the Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech vaccines,
- Or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine
- Or if visiting from another country, AstraZeneca, Sinopharm-BB/BP, Sinovac, & Novavax

Proof of Vaccination may be established by any of the following methods:

- CDC COVID-19 Vaccine Record Card (hard copy), or photo of the card
- Printed certificate or QR code from MyIR Mobile
- Documented proof of vaccination from a medical record or vaccine provider including an individual’s doctor, pharmacy, or other official immunization record from within or outside the U.S.

Option for individuals who are unvaccinated or unable to prove vaccine status:

- Negative FDA-approved molecular (e.g., PCR) test within the previous 72 hours (test must be conducted no more than 72 hours prior to the visit).
- Digital or printed documentation of the negative test result from a testing agent, including a laboratory, health care provider, or pharmacy.
- *NOTE: Rapid tests are not accepted.*

King County requires proof of COVID-19 vaccination or a negative test at this establishment.


