### Mission Statement:

To produce exemplary Washington State wines in the style of European blends, while providing a holistic customer experience and rewarding our employees, suppliers, and investors.

### History:

Brian Carter produced his first blend with the 1997 vintage of Solesce. It was Spring of 2006 when the full line of blends was released, making Brian Carter Cellars the first Washington winery to focus entirely on blended wines. In 2006, Brian Carter Cellars opened its current tasting room in Woodinville. In June of 2007, production was moved from the Apex Winery in Sunnyside to Woodinville. In 2020 our Vancouver Tasting Room & Wine Bar starts operations.

- **Abracadabra:** A Magical Red Blend
- **Abracadabra Rosé:** A Magical Rosé Blend
- **Byzance:** Grenache based Southern Rhone-Style Red Blend
- **Corrida:** Tempranillo based Spanish-Style Red Blend
- **Le Coursier:** Bordeaux-Style Blend (Right Bank)
- **Opulento:** Fortified Port-Style wine made from traditional Port varieties
- **Oriana:** Viognier based, Unique Aromatic White Blend
- **Solesce:** Flagship Bordeaux-Style Blend (Left Bank)
- **Trentenaire:** Unique Petit Verdot based Bordeaux-Style Blend
- **Tuttorosso:** Vibrant Sangiovese based Super Tuscan-Style Red Blend
